This demand must be held in conjunction with the entire women’s question according to Socialist precepts. The Women’s Day must have an international character and is to be prepared carefully.”

Resolution by Clara Zetkin, adopted by the Second International Conference of Socialist Women, held August 26-27, 1910, in Copenhagen, Denmark. This resolution launched the organized celebration of March 8 as International Women’s Day.
